#### Research Databases and Reference Centers

**Academic Search Premier** is a multidisciplinary database containing thousands of full-text articles from popular magazines and scholarly journals as well as video content from the Associated Press, the world's leading news agency.

**Business Source Elite** provides full-text coverage of top business, management and economics journals and periodicals. Topics include accounting, banking, finance, marketing, sales and more.

#### **ERIC (Education Resources Information Center)**

provides access to educational literature and resources. The database contains more than 1.6 million records, links to hundreds of thousands of full-text documents, and an education-specific thesaurus.

*GreenFILE* offers a collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles covering all aspects of human impact to the environment. Topics include global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling and more.

Legal Information Reference Center offers tools and detailed how-to instructions covering a wide range of legal issues. It includes full text for many top consumer legal reference books, including Nolo's do-it-yourself guides, as well as thousands of legal forms.

*Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts* (*LISTA*) provides indexing and abstracting for hundreds of key journals, books and research reports on topics such as librarianship, cataloging, classification, information retrieval, bibliometrics and more.

Literary Reference Center includes thousands of critical essays, book reviews, literary journals, author biographies, plot summaries and more covering all literary genres and timeframes. It also contains full text for classic novels, short stories and poems.

*MasterFILE Elite* provides full-text magazines, periodicals and reference books covering a wide range of subject areas.

Middle Search Plus contains complete articles from popular middle school magazines such as Cobblestone, National Geographic, TIME and Sports Illustrated Kids, as well as thousands of biographies, historical essays, primary source documents, images and Associated Press videos.

**Military & Government Collection** includes full-text journals and periodicals pertaining to all branches of the military and government. It is designed to offer current news to military members, analysts, policy makers, students and researchers.

**Points of View Reference Center** provides rich, diverse content to help students and researchers assess and craft persuasive arguments and essays, better understand controversial issues, and develop analytical thinking skills.

**Primary Search** contains easy-to-read encyclopedia entries, a vast image collection, and complete articles from popular children's magazines, such as *Cricket and Highlights*.

**Referencia Latina** is a full-text Spanish-language database covering a broad array of subjects. Content includes reference books, general interest magazines and health reports.

**Regional Business News** provides full-text regional business publications for the United States and Canadian provinces. Users can search newspapers, magazines and other resources from trusted news sources.

**Small Business Reference Center** offers exclusive full text for many top consumer small business reference books, including Nolo's do-it-yourself guides. Users will find business videos, a help and advice section, and details on how to create business plans.

**Teacher Reference Center** provides indexing and abstracts for more than 230 peer-reviewed journals covering assessment, curriculum development, instruction, literacy, educational leadership and more.
