## Borough of Carteret Waterfront Park Marina MARINA SEASONAL SLIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**1)** Boat safety training/certification required.

2) One marina vehicle pass will be issued to permit entrance to Waterfront Park Marina Parking Lot B, where the marina entrance is located. Use of facilities at other lots may require payment of the appropriate fee at the park.

**3)** Long-term boat trailer storage space is not currently available at Carteret Waterfront Park, but will be available off-site in the future.

4) The Borough of Carteret reserves the right to assign or re-assign slips in order to efficiently utilize all available slips.

**5)** In the event a boat is sold, Permittee will notify the Borough, and the Borough at its sole discretion may authorize the transfer of a slip to a new owner. Any other assignment, subletting, or transferring, directly or indirectly, by the Permittee is prohibited. Any and all rights and privileges granted by this permit are for the sole use of the Permittee.

6) Length shall be the total length of the vessel including all accessories, bow pulpits, swim platforms, extensions, brackets, and motors. Length may be verified by the Harbormaster and rates or slip location adjusted accordingly.

7) All vessels are required to be equipped with a radar reflecting device and comply with all marina safety conditions and procedures as described in the Carteret Marina Boater Safety Course."

**8)** The annual season runs from April 1st through October 31st. All seasonal boats must be removed from the marina by the fourth Monday in October. (Per night fee may be assessed for late removals). Wet marina winter storage is available for the off-season.

**9)** Slips shall be kept neat and orderly. Runways and boardwalks must be kept clear at all times. Rowboats, dinghies, and other accessory equipment must be kept within the confines of the assigned slip. Carpeting, tires, fire hoses, TV antennas, bicycles etc., are not to be attached to the piers, catwalks or piles. Painting, stripping of paint, hanging clothes and laundry are prohibited. Heads (toilets) shall be dumped in designated pump-out stations only.

**10)** Open fires will not be allowed at the Carteret Waterfront Park Marina. Any condition aboard or around the boat that is deemed a fire hazard, in the opinion of the Marina Operator, Harbor Master, or Carteret Fire Department, shall be removed immediately.

**11)** All park rules and regulations as well as applicable State and Federal rules and regulations will be observed. When rules and regulations relating to public safety have been violated, the Borough of Carteret reserves the right to reject any application for a slip, and to terminate without prior notice or refund, any permit issued. Amplification of music or other sound is not permitted.

**12)** Marina users shall respect the rights and privacy of others and maintain quiet hours from 11:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m..

**13)** Water and electrical accessories must be approved by the Harbor Master. Water may not be available during early and/or late season. Modification of park electric equipment and supply is prohibited.

14) The Permittee assumes all risks related to this permit and shall be solely responsible and answerable in damages for all accidents or injuries to person or property, and hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify and keep harmless the Borough of Carteret; the Department of Parks and Recreation, Port Authority; their officers and employees; from any and all claims, suits, losses, damage or injury to person or property of whatsoever kind or nature, whether direct or indirect, arising out of the operation of this Permit, or the carelessness, negligence or improper conduct of the Permittee or any servant, agent or employee thereof.

**15)** The Borough of Carteret shall not be responsible for property damage or personal injury to the Permittee, or any person upon the premises at the invitation of the Permittee.

**17)** Special permits are required for commericial activities.


