

CARTERET HOUSING AUTHORITY

The Carteret Housing Authority will be opening the waiting list for the Housing Choice Voucher Mainstream Program commencing on 11/10/22 at 9:00AM for the first 50 applicants who are eligible for the adopted resident and disabled preferences. This specifically means that the head of household or spouse must be disabled, the disabled individual must be between the age of 18 and 61, and the applicant must be a resident as defined in the Housing Authority's Administrative Plan, which states that proof of permanent disability is required and a resident is "a family who lives, works or who has been hired to work in the jurisdiction of the PHA". The PHA's jurisdiction is the Borough of Carteret. All applicants and proxies must provide verification of the claimed disabled preference and two forms of identification verifying the resident preference. Applications are given out on a first come first serve basis until such time as the Authority receives 50 qualifying applicants for the program.

Please only apply if you meet the criteria specified above as all applicants that do not qualify for these preferences will be denied admission to the waiting list. Additionally, if you incorrectly or incompletely fill out the application form, your form will be denied. Individuals wishing to apply may only submit one application per person.

Applications must be picked up at the Housing Authority Office located at 96 Roosevelt Ave, Carteret, NJ 07008 during the normal business hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm.
