







State Awards \$2.4M boardwalk grant to forthcoming Carteret Riverwalk



The Borough will receive \$2.4 million in state funding for its forthcoming Carteret Riverwalk, the southern portion of which is pictured.

Gov. Phil Murphy's administration recently announced the award of \$100 million in Boardwalk Preservation Fund grants to 18 municipalities to assist them in addressing the most critical and necessary capital needs of boardwalks in their communities.

The Borough received \$2.4 million for its forthcoming Riverwalk.

"We are very grateful to Gov. Murphy and the state Department of Community Affairs for their generous aid in helping Carteret to continue to improve its wonderful waterfront and become even more of a destination," Mayor Daniel J. Reiman said.

Administered by the DCA, the grant funding aims to help communities remain vibrant tourism destinations in the long term by investing in state-of-the-art materials that increase storm resiliency and ensure longer lasting infrastructure.

The Boardwalk Preservation Fund is made possible through federal funding from the American Rescue Plan Coronavirus State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, which have been dedicated by the governor and the state legislature to an array of economic recovery and revitalization projects across New Jersey. Carteret is the only Middlesex County municipality to receive funding, as well as the most northern town in the state to be awarded funds.

New Jersey coastal counties and municipalities with existing boardwalks that sought funding for boardwalk construction, repair, and maintenance were eligible to apply. Projects had to meet at least one of the following criteria: boardwalk construction that adds new boardwalk components, boardwalk maintenance, boardwalk reconstruction or repair of ancillary or appurtenant structures.

Projects included improving access and safety by building ADA-compliant ramps and railings and expanding an existing section of the boardwalk. The grant must be expended by Dec. 31, 2026.

Central Jersey Arts Council presents three-day paper mache workshop



From March 18 to 20, Central Jersey Arts Council will present a three-day workshop on creating arts and crafts with paper mache. The class will be from 5 to 7 p.m. each day at Blazing Star Cultural Arts Center, pictured.

The Arts Committee of Central Jersey Arts Council will present a three-day Paper Mache Workshop Series that will take participants through the entire process of crafting with the accessible, affordable technique.

Paper mache is a composite material consisting of paper pieces or pulp, sometimes reinforced with textiles, and bound with an adhesive, such as glue, starch, or wallpaper paste.

The workshop series will take place 5 to 7 p.m. March 18 to 20 at Blazing Star Cultural Arts Center, 63 Carteret Ave.

"Over three enriching sessions, discover the endless possibilities of this versatile medium and unleash your imagination to craft stunning sculptures and artworks," Central Jersey Arts Council Executive Director Elham Hussain said.

"Session 1: Introduction to Paper Mache" on March 18 will explore the fundamentals of paper mache as workshop delves into its history, materials, and basic techniques.

"Get hands-on experience and learn how to create a sturdy base for future masterpieces," Hussain said.

"Session 2: Sculpting with Paper Mache" on March 19 will dive deeper into the artform as the workshop focuses on sculpting techniques. From forming intricate details to shaping larger structures, participants will be able to unleash their creativity and bring their ideas to life in three dimensions.

At "Session 3: Painting and Finishing Touches" on March 20, participants will discover the art of painting and adding finishing touches to their paper mache creations. They also will learn how to use colors, textures, and embellishments to enhance the beauty of their sculptures and make them unique.

No prior experience is required, and all materials will be provided.

"Just bring your enthusiasm and a willingness to explore new artistic horizons," Hussain said. "Unlock your creativity and join us for an unforgettable journey into the world of paper mache artistry. We look forward to crafting with you!"

Earth Day Celebration Will Feature Storytime with Carteret Author

Borough-based children's author Dominique J. Duvalsaint's tales for youngsters were inspired by her three children: Kem, 7; Ony, 6, and Chigoze, 3. Since December 2022, she has self-published three books:

• "Sky's First Swimming Lesson," her most recent outing about a young girl's effort to learn to swim, as well as stand up to bullies

• "A King of Chess," a young boy's quest to learn chess and inspire other youngsters to enjoy the benefits of the strategic game

• "Victor Discovers the Violin," her debut about a child's love of music, his dream to perform it with an orchestra performance; his reality of using of household items to play.

"Inspiration can come from anywhere," Duvalsaint said. "Most of mine are from my children. Things they do or say are my best inspirations."

On April 20, Duvalsaint will read and sell her books at the Third Annual Carteret Earth Day Celebration in Carteret Park (see flyer on page 10). Her previous appearance in Carteret was at a Feb. 23 book signing at the public library.

Each book is illustrated by Canadian artist Yuliia Zolotova, who collaborates remotely.

Future topics she plans to explore include the value of science, technology, engineering and math edu-

cation (STEM), nutrition, parental monitoring of children's online activity, and teaching children to prepare for their financial future.

A 2004 Pace University grad, Dominique, 43, briefly worked for a telecommunications company before she and her family moved to South Korea. She found work in that southwestern province, teaching English as a second language to third-to-sixth graders. Duvalsaint became "conversational" in Korean.

Duvalsaint became "conversational" in Korean. She is also fluent in French and Haitian-Creole. Her influential parents are Haitian.

After several years in South Korea, Duvalsaint returned to the United States with husband, Mayor, whom she met abroad.

The couple made their home in Brooklyn and moved to Carteret a few years ago, attracted by its lower cost of living, quiet neighborhoods, and good public schools.

"Carteret is a good place to raise children," she said. An adjunct ESL educator at Union County College, Duvalsaint also is a licensed real estate salesperson. She received a 2021 master's degree in ESL from Framingham State University in Massachusetts,

In addition to writing children's books, she plans to create an online platform to help parents teach youngsters how to enjoy reading.

Home of the Central Jersey Marquee Awards, which once again will honor the best of Central Jersey high school music theater talent on May 15, the venue 12



The founding lead guitarist of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame act KISS, Ace Frehley will bring his classic rock hits to CPAC on April 13. Presented by WDHA 105.5-FM, the 6:30 p.m. show also will include a reunion of White Tiger and a performance by the super group Angel, featuring members of Punky Meadows.

Frehley's 2014 LP, "Space Invader," is the only solo album by a KISS member to crack the Top 10 on Billboard's Top 200 albums chart. He also found success with his 2011 autobiography, "No Regrets," which was a New York Times bestseller.

"I'm 72 years old and still sound like I did in the '70s," Frehley recently told Guitar World magazine. "I get a kick out of the fact that I can do this like I did then ... I can go out there without bombs, makeup and costumes. I'm in jeans and a T-shirt, playing like I did when I was 25.




